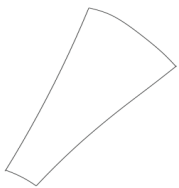
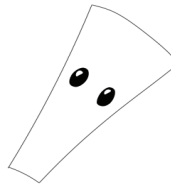


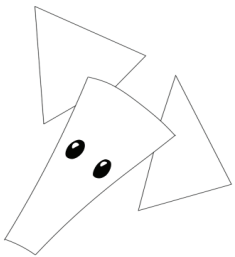
How to Draw a Bravos Dog



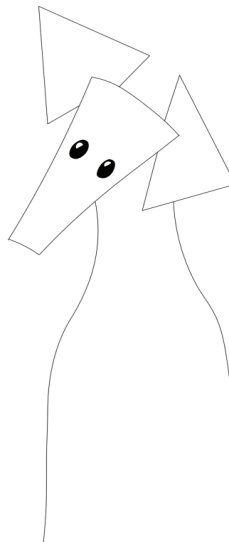
1. Draw the head. The shape is rectangular that tapers on one end.



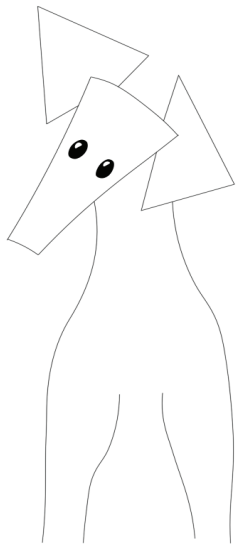
2. Draw two circles for the eyes and fill in, leaving a white spot for a highlight.



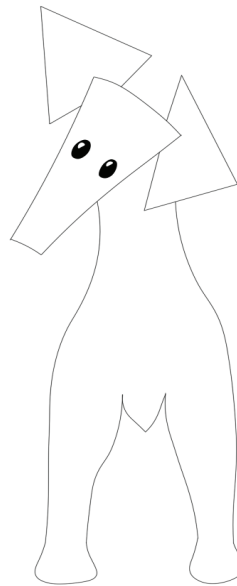
3. Add the ears, which are two fairly large triangles, on either side of the head.



4. Time to draw the body! A trick for the body is to think about drawing the outline of a bottle, leaving out the bottom line.



5. Using the body you just drew as a guide, draw the legs.



6. The chest of the *Bravos* dogs are quite pointy! Think of a triangular shape when drawing the chest.

Use circular shapes to add the paws.



7. The tails in the painting are fan-shaped. Make yours as big and dramatic as you want!



8. Add details! Triangles, dots, lines, whatever you feel like fits your dog.

Use your imagination!
